

Mitsinjo Reforestation Project 2015 FwB Partnership



The 2015 FwB Mitsinjo reforestation is underway both literally and figuratively laying the ground work for this year's reforestation season through the placement of the potting beds with in the nursery. This process required 6 phases including the first phase collection of wood and bamboo.

The second phase was the preparation of the seedbed and starting construction of the potting bed.

The preparation of the nursery bed involved obtaining potting soil and collection of hummus from the forest and sand from the river and filling the pots by hand.¹

The collection of seeds has also begun and will continue as the different tree species produce seeds. Also previously collected seedlings were sown into the seedbed and some seedling were transferred to the potting beds as well.
